MINUTES OF THE 287th MEETING OF THE REVIEW COMMITTEE ON GENETIC MANIPULATION (RCGM) HELD ON 26.06.2024 BY VIDEO CONFERENCING (GO TO MEETING)

The Chairman-RCGM extended a formal welcome to the members of the RCGM for the 287th meeting and initiated the process of the meeting. The list of participants is given at Annexure-I.

- 2. The Committee adopted the minutes and recommendations of the 286th meeting of the RCGM held on 12.06.2024.
- 3. On the action taken report, the Member-Secretary informed that during the 286th meeting of the RCGM, a total of 36 applications including information items were considered and the Secretariat is in the process of issuing requisite permit letters based on the recommendations of the RCGM.

4. Proposals considered

4.1 Applications in the area of Pharmaceuticals

The Committee considered the applications to export V2A antibody; to import and transfer *M. tuberculosis* H37Rv and its mutants; to conduct preclinical toxicity studies on Dupilumab Biosimilar and Pembrolizumab monoclonal antibody Biosimilar. After deliberation on each application including information items, appropriate decisions were taken by the RCGM.

4.2 Applications in the area of Agriculture

The Committee considered the applications to transfer seeds of GE rice lines; to receive leaf materials of GE corn; to export seeds of GE maize; Record of Planting, Transport, and Storage, Trial site map, and photograph of the trial site for the BRL-I 1st year trial of GE cotton; request to include additional locations to conduct EST of GE cotton lines and BRL I 1st year trial of GE cotton hybrids; discussion on the draft annexure to RCGM permit letters issued for the conduct of confined field trials; exemption of exogenous DNA free genome edited *Brassica juncea* lines. After deliberation on each application including information items, appropriate decisions were taken by the RCGM.

5. IBSC Reports

The Committee considered minutes submitted by twenty-six IBSCs, twelve annual compliance reports and nil medical surveillance reports, and appropriate decisions were taken by the RCGM.

6. Other items

The Committee considered Applications recommended by the Inter-Ministerial Committee for Certification of BSL-3 facility; Information on discontinuation/decommissioning of BSL-3 laboratory at the R&D centre.

No other transaction took place, and the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and members.
